Hurricane Mitigation Retrofit Requirements and/or secondary waterproofing when an existing roof is replaced. Only site built single family residences are included in the requirement for mitigation retrofits and/or secondary waterproofing per Florida Statute 553.844, and only sloped hipped or gable roofs are required to comply.
